JONATHAN ROBERTSON



Thompson's London invites you to view the exhibition of Jonathan Robertson's latest oil paintings.

Jonathan Robertson's cheerful and observational paintings that depict portside labourers or green-fingered gardeners are delightful tributes to the workforces that make their living from either land or sea. His paintings eschew conventional modes of perspective and deliver their subjects as though they were written into the background like an ancient fresco or wall carving; the subjects are irreducible from their surroundings. Robertson's distinctive characters have come to be synonymous with his name, the brushwork is immediately recognisable as his own, yet he continues to surprise with every new work – each painting illustrates an image that stands alone.

Jonathan Robertson was born and brought up in the fishing community of Banff, north east of Scotland, in 1947 and went on to study at Glasgow School of Art. The quality and universality of Robertson's work has led him to have shows as far wide as Moscow, New York and Berlin to name a few. Widely collected and critically acclaimed, Robertson continues to enjoy the pleasure of painting and his work is lovingly received across the world. Represented in exhibitions at Thompson's Galleries since 2000, Robertson's latest works are as fresh and enjoyable as when they first graced the walls of the gallery more than ten years previous.
